

Important Camp Information for Students Enrolled in the College Tennis Exposure Camp at Brandeis University

(We recommend you print out this document)

1. Student Check-in – Student check-in will be held Saturday, July 28, from 7:30-8:00 a.m. at the Rieger Tennis Courts, located behind the Gosman Center at Brandeis University. The address is: 415 South Street, Waltham, MA 02453.
2. Closing Ceremony – The camp concludes Sunday, July 29, at 4 p.m. Parents are welcome to come to the closing ceremony for students at 3:45 p.m. at the Rieger Tennis Courts.
3. Physical Exam and Immunization Records -- Every student must present a Physical Exam and Immunization Record (dated within 24 months prior to camp) from their doctor in order to participate in the camp at Brandeis University. In addition, the camp medical form must be filled out online or downloaded and turned in prior to the start of camp. Adequate health insurance is essential for all students attending the camp. In the event of a medical emergency, all medical costs must be paid for by the student, parent or guardian.
4. Local Hotel Accommodations – For families requiring overnight accommodations, a discounted group rate has been arranged with the Courtyard Marriott. Click on the preferred link below for online reservations:

6. Directions to Brandeis University – Brandeis University is located at: 415 South Street, Waltham, MA 02453.

From the Massachusetts Turnpike (Interstate 90) Eastbound

Take exit 14 for I-95/Rt 128. After the toll, keep left for 95/128 North. While on ramp, exit immediately onto exit 24 for Route 30. Bear left onto Route 30. Turn right at first traffic light onto River Road. Follow this for 1.5 miles, where it turns into South Street. Gosman Athletic Center and tennis courts are one-half mile ahead on the right, at 415 South Street.

From the Massachusetts Turnpike (Interstate 90) Westbound

Take exit 15 for I-95/Rt 128 and Route 30. After the toll proceed straight for Route 30. Turn right at end of the ramp, and then right again at first traffic light onto Route 30. Turn left at next traffic light onto River Road. Follow this for 1.5 miles, where it turns into South Street. Gosman Athletic Center and tennis courts are one-half mile ahead on the right, at 415 South Street.

From I-95/Route 128 Southbound

From I-95/Route 128 Southbound: Take exit 24 for Route 30. At end of ramp, proceed through traffic light (across Route 30). This is River Road (River Road becomes South Street). Gosman Athletic Center and tennis courts are one-half mile ahead on the right, at 415 South Street.

From I-95/Route 128 Northbound

Take exit 24 for Route 30. Route 30 is one of several options at this exit, so follow signs carefully. Turn left at the top of the ramp onto Route 30. Turn right at the traffic lights. This is South Street. Gosman Athletic Center and tennis courts are one-half mile ahead on the right, at 415 South Street.

7. Cancellation and Inclement Weather Policy -- A refund (less a \$75 processing fee) will be provided to anyone who cancels more than 30 days prior to the start of camp. If you cancel, for any reason, within 30 days of the start of the camp, you will receive a full credit toward a College Tennis Exposure Camp (valid through December 2019). There will be no credit or refund for any student who must leave the camp for illness, injury or any other reason, once the camp has started. In the event of rain at any point during the camp, we will use the indoor tennis facility at Brandeis. Since our entire coaching staff will be working rain or shine, there will be no refund or credit in the event of inclement weather.
