

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR COLLEGE TENNIS EXPOSURE CAMP
AT MERCER COUNTY PARK TENNIS FACILITY– JULY 20-21, 2024

1. Check-in will be held Saturday, July 20, from 7:30-8:00 a.m. at the Mercer County Commission Tennis Facility (1667 Mercerville-Edinburg Road, West Windsor, NJ 08550). The camp will start at 8:15 a.m.
2. Local hotels will accommodate students staying with parents. For hotel reservations, call or book online:

3. Catered boxed lunch (including a turkey sandwich, chips and a cookie) will be provided for campers both days. Any camper with special dietary needs should bring their own lunch. Parents are encouraged to dine at one of the numerous local restaurants or get food to go.
4. Tennis Questionnaire – The Tennis Questionnaire should be completed at least 14 days before the start of the camp. Click on the link to complete the questionnaire online.

5. Cancellation and Inclement Weather Policy -- A refund (less a \$75 processing fee) will be provided to anyone who cancels more than 30 days prior to the start of camp. If you cancel, for any reason, within 30 days of the start of the camp, you will receive a full credit toward a College Tennis Exposure Camp (valid through December 2025). There will be no credit or refund for any student who must leave the camp for illness, injury or any other reason, once the camp has started. In the event of rain at any point during the weekend, we will use the indoor tennis courts at Mercer County Park. Since our entire coaching staff will be working rain or shine, there will be no refund or credit in the event of inclement weather.
6. Required Packing List
 - a. Racquets - at least two (2), pre-strung
 - b. Water will be provided on court, but players need to supply their own insulated drinking bottle or thermos. Players are welcome to bring their own sports beverages.
 - c. Notebook and two pens
 - d. Sunscreen (SPF 30 or higher), hat or visor
 - e. We recommend parents bring a folding beach chair & umbrella if they intend to watch the camp.
